Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to our summer term in Year 2. We hope you all had a happy Easter break and managed to have a rest and a chance to recharge a little! The children have made a fantastic start and we are enjoying being back in the routines of school, we have all been so impressed with how the children have settled back into the class and school again! Thank you Class 2!

Our aim is to make this final term as settled, calm and as productive as we can to support the children to reach their full potential. Please do not hesitate to come and see us if you have any concerns or questions.

Thank you for your continued support with your child's reading, spelling and Homework Grid activities. Regular reading practise of their books is also very much appreciated, when possible. It would also be extremely helpful if you could question your child about their text to support with their comprehension and inference skills.

Below is a summary of the curriculum coverage we will be looking at this term.

English - We are using 'A Cloudy Lesson' to write diary entries, dialogue between characters and instructional writing. Through all these forms of writing we will continue to focus on spelling, punctuation and language choices.

Maths - We will be looking at Fractions and time this half term. As well as continuing to revisit our number work.


Science - We will be looking at 'Plants' this term, building on the knowledge the children attained in Year 1. We are looking forward to our planting and growing investigations, working on our hypothesis and recording and presenting our results.

Geography - We will be looking at why some countries are hotter than others, with a comparison of the UK with Norway and Singapore.

Computing - We will be using 'Purple mash' to create multimedia stories inserting sound and movement!

PE - We will be working together on team activities and challenges based around Striking and Fielding skills to develop teamwork, cooperation and creative thinking.

Art - This term we will be developing our 2D and 3D skills looking at different forms of artwork based on nature and natural materials.



RE - We will be looking at Jesus and the stories he told, discussing the themes and messages from the stories.

Music - we will be focusing on the pulse in music, pitch and rhythm, and looking at different musical styles.

As we are now in the summer term, please could children make sure they have a water bottle in school, sun hat and sun cream protection, (Pre applied if possible), for those hot days, when or if they arrive!
