Key Vocabulary

Mini beasts 	A small creature with no back bone, like an insect or spider	Farming 	The process of growing crops or animals
Flower 	A plant that produces a flower bloom	Tractor 	Powerful vehicle with large wheels that is used to perform jobs on a farm
Stem 	The long supportive middle part of a plant	Ploughing 	Turning over the soil ready to then plant seeds
Root 	The part of a plant that branches out under ground, holds the plant in place and sucks up water	Planting 	Putting a seed, bulb or plant in the ground for it to grow
Leaf 	A flat part attached to the stem that uses light to make food	Harvesting 	Gathering a crop once it has grown
Islam 	The religion of Muslims	Life Cycle 	A living thing that gets bigger and changes over time.
Eid 	The Muslim festival celebrating the end of a month of fasting	Egg, hatching, duckling, duck 	The key stages of a ducks life
