Waterproof	A material that does not let water pass through	Natural Features like forest, volcano, river	Things found when the dinosaurs were alive in the past with no humans
Not Waterproof	A material that does let water pass through and feels 'soggy'	Carnivore	A creature that eats other creatures
Litter	Pieces of rubbish left on the ground, not in a bin	Herbivore	A creature that eats plants
Recycling	Turning waste materials into something new to be used again	Omnivore	A creature that eats both other creatures and plants
Habitat  ocean forest  desert grassland	A natural home for a plant or animal	Easter	A Christian religious festival to celebrate Jesus coming back to life
Dinosaurs	A group of creatures that lived a very long time ago in the past. They now do not exist	Spring	The season after winter where plants begin to regrow
