Solve

If a heraldic banner depicting a coat of arms is three feet wide by four feet in length, what is the area of the banner? What is the perimeter of the banner? There are 12 inches in one foot. What is the perimeter in inches?



Reimagine

Historically, knights were represented by coats of arms. Design a coat of arms to represent your family. Think about the meanings of colours and symbols.



Discuss

Knighthoods and orders of chivalry date back centuries. Is chivalry old fashioned? Are such ideas outdated? Should they be abolished or reinvented?



Discover

Fact: The Order of the Garter is the senior order of chivalry in the UK and was founded in 1348 by King Edward III.

Question: What other orders of knights exist? What do they do?



Cptn Tom Knighted **Answers**

What is the area of the banner?

To calculate the area, multiply the length and width:

$$3' \times 4' = 12'^2$$

What is the perimeter of the banner?

To calculate the perimeter, add the length of all of the sides together:

$$3' + 4' + 3' + 4' = 14'$$

What is the perimeter in inches?

There are 12 inches in one foot.

$$\text{Width: } 3' \times 12 = 36''$$

$$\text{Length: } 4' \times 12 = 48''$$

$$36'' + 48'' + 36'' + 48'' = 168''$$
