

## Le café – the café

### Years 3 & 4

Have a go at setting up your own French café at home. You can use real food, pretend food, pictures of food or just your imagination. You can ask your family members to be your customers. Use counters or buttons (or a suitable equivalent) for money. Decide what prices you will charge in euros, and don't forget to use your French counting skills. Think about the following:

- Greet your customers: **Bonjour Monsieur / Bonjour Madame**
- Ask what they would like to eat or drink: **Tu veux du lait?** (Would you like some milk?) / **Tu veux du chocolat?** (Would you like some chocolate?)
- Don't forget to use your manners: **s'il te plaît** (please)/**merci beaucoup** (thank you)
- Decide what you are going to charge: **Deux euros s'il te plaît.**
- Say "thank you" and "goodbye": **Merci et au revoir!**
