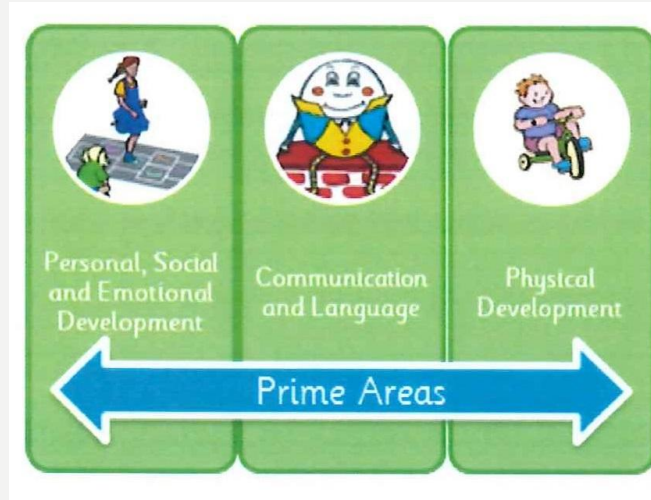

Learning through play, exploration and active engagement.

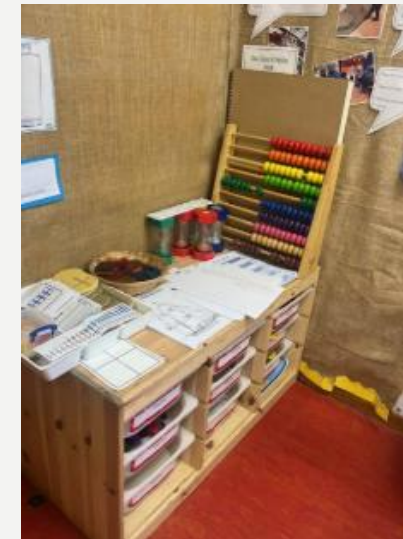


OUR LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

THINGS YOUR CHILD WILL NEED

- A **water bottle**, to be brought each day and taken home each night. They have access to these throughout the day

LUNCH



- Each day your child can choose whether they have the free school meal (entitled to until the end of KSI) or they can bring their own packed lunch. **NO NUTS.**
- All they will have to do is put their name on the correct side of the self register.



SNACK TIME!

- **Milk** – milk is provided by Cool Milk – the week your child turns five they will stop receiving free milk and they will need to pay for it and register online.
- They will get a piece of **seasonal fruit or vegetable** each day. All children are encouraged to try some, but of course they don't have to.
- You can send your child with a piece of preferred fruit, if you wish.



THINGS YOU WILL NEED TO KNOW

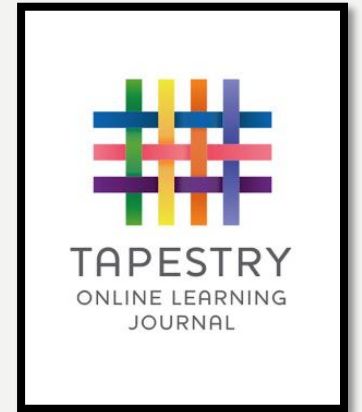


- You will receive a termly **newsletter, homework grid and knowledge organiser**. These are emailed out.
- **End of day** – if there are any changes to your usual pick-up arrangements, please inform us in advance. For safety reasons, we cannot release your child to anyone we have not been previously notified about.
- **Medicines** – The school is only permitted to administer medication that has been prescribed by a doctor. A consent form is available in the office and must be completed beforehand.
- If your child uses an inhaler, it is essential that one is kept at school at all times. Your child should also be able to use it independently, including pressing the inhaler themselves.

HOME & SCHOOL COMMUNICATION



- There is always a member of staff at the gate in the morning. They are happy to pass on message.
- Once your child has started, you will receive an invitation to access their Tapestry profile. This platform will be used to upload homework, allowing us to see what your child has been practicing at home. We will also occasionally share photos and updates about what your child has been learning in school.
- We have a class email that you can use also for messages and queries (non urgent).

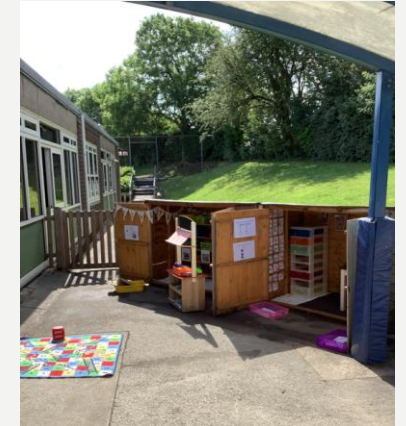
