Grammar

Children study areas of grammar including:

Nouns (their gender, and whether they are singular or Plural);

Determiners (definite & indefinite articles);

Adjectives (masculine, feminine & plural agreements, as well as possessive adjectives);

Verbs (including negative and imperative forms);

Questions (noting inversion of verb & subject);

Prepositions (positional language)

Phonic Focus
