
Gestation period (pregnancy)

- Gestation period is the length of time when the foetus develops in the female's uterus.
- The gestation period is different for different animals.
- Larger animals, like elephants, have a longer gestation period.
- Smaller animals, like mice, have a shorter gestation period and often give birth to bigger litters.

Adolescence

- Adolescence is the stage of development in humans between childhood and adulthood.
- Puberty is the name for the physical changes that happen during adolescence. They occur so that adults can reproduce.
- Adolescents experience changes in the way they:
 - Look
 - > Think
 - > Feel
 - **>** behave
- Emotional changes are caused by hormones.
- Hormones are chemical 'messengers' that travel around the body in the blood.
