














Key Vocabulary

Pirate 	A person who attacks and steals from other ships at sea	Sink 	When an item goes below the top of water and falls to the bottom
Pirate Ship 	A large boat powered by wind and sails	Sea life 	Creatures living in the sea e.g Fish, Shark, Whale, Dolphin, Octopus, Turtle, Jellyfish...
Jolly Roger 	The traditional flag flown by pirates with a black background and white skull and cross bones	Sea Bed 	The bottom of the ocean
Treasure Map 	A map which marks the location of buried treasure	Coral Reef 	Rock under the sea formed by the growth of coral.
Natural Features 	Natural parts of a landscape e.g. mountains and rivers.	Midnight Zone 	A deep part of the ocean where no sunlight reaches
Human Features 	Parts of a landscape created by people e.g. buildings and bridges	Ark 	The wooden ship built by Noah in the Bible to save every kind of animal from the flood
Float 	When an item sits on or near the top of water	Summer 	The warmest season of the year
