<b>Wood</b> - is a natural material - grows from trees	  	<b>Metal</b> - is a natural material - comes from ore in rocks	  
<b>Plastic</b> - is a man-made material - is made from oil	  	<b>Stone</b> - is a natural material - comes from rocks	 
<b>Glass</b> - is a man-made material - is made from sand	  	<b>Fabric</b> - can be a natural or man-made material - is made from wool, cotton or oil
