Year 2 Autumn Term 2 Newsletter



Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back! We hope you have all had a lovely half term. The children have done very well settling back into the routine of Class 2 and we are impressed with how hard they are working.

English: This half term we will be exploring the humorous book 'Wolves' by Emily Gravett. This text will enable the children to write a non-chronological leaflet, captions, information writing, character descriptions and comparisons. The unit will encourage the children to think carefully about fact and fiction.

Maths: Work this half term will continue to include counting on and back in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's, number sequences, place value showing different representations of two-digit numbers using tens and ones equipment, as well as part, part-whole models and tens grids. We will also continue to look at how we can use and apply this knowledge when problem solving involving addition and subtraction. We will also be learning the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Other curriculum areas we will be covering will include:

PE: The children will take part in 2 PE lessons each week, which will be on Tuesdays and Fridays. Please ensure that your child has a full PE kit in school at all times. Also, it would be a huge help if both their PE kit and school uniform are clearly labelled with their name, to prevent anything getting lost or mixed up. Thank you!

Science: This half term we will continue to look at the uses of everyday materials, focusing on practical investigations to find solutions, for example the best waterproof material for a hat. We will also be quizzing the children on the content of our Science knowledge organizer.

History: Our topic this half-term is 'What is special about Cropwell Bishop?' We will explore our local environment, looking at how the village and village life has changed over time.

DT: This half term we will be looking at 'Food Tech and Prep'. This will involve preparing and tasting different healthy fruit and vegetable dips and dippers, deciding on what would work well and what would not. In addition, we will be discussing tastes and textures, leading onto likes and dislikes.

RE: This half term we will look at 'Celebrations.' These will involve Eid, Hannukah and Christmas as part of our Islam and Christianity focus. We will also be practising and performing the Christian story of 'The First Christmas' at out Nativity play.

Music: We will be practising and learning songs to perform at our Nativity play.

Computing: Our first computing session of each half-term is focused on e-safety. After this, the children will be using Purple Mash and creating a graph using information from our history lessons around amenities in Cropwell Bishop.

We really appreciate the support you give and we hope that you will be able to continue to encourage and help your child in doing the following activities at home:

Reading: Daily practice of reading books and non-school books, as appropriate. We strongly encourage year 2 children to have as much reading experience as possible to develop their reading confidence, comprehension skills and to help them become independent readers. Just like last half term, your child will get opportunities during the week to change their book when they are ready for a new one. It would be really appreciated if you could sign your child's reading record when they have read at home with you, so we can move them up on our reading racing track. Phonics/Spelling: In class children will continue to have daily phonics sessions where they will continue with the Read Write Inc scheme. Spellings will be sent home on a Friday and will be tested the following Friday.
