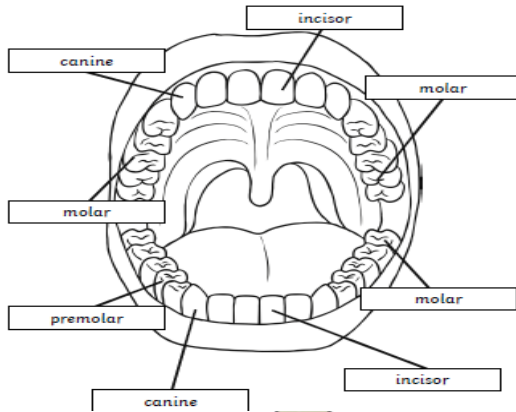
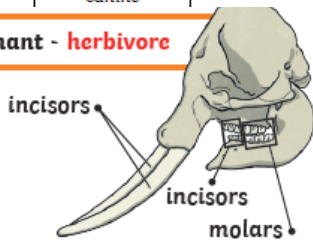
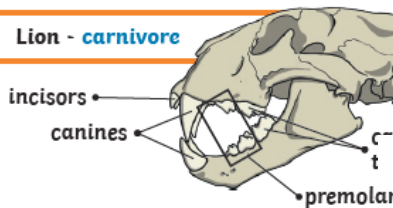




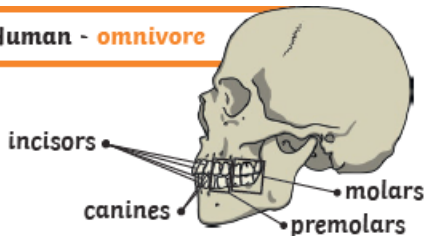
Elephant - herbivore



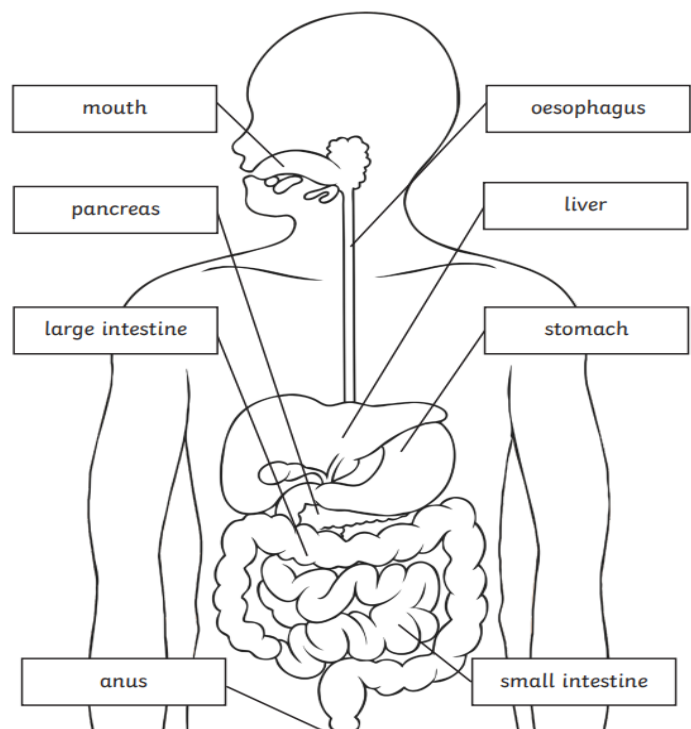
Lion - carnivore

incisor	Teeth which bite and cut food.
canine	Teeth which rip and tear food.
premolar	Teeth which hold and crush food.
molar	Teeth which grind food.
digestion	Breaking down food to be used by the body
oesophagus	Muscular tube which moves food from the mouth to the stomach.
stomach	Bag-like organ where food is broken down by stomach acid and by being churned.
small intestine	Part of intestine where nutrients are absorbed
anus	Opening where waste is excreted
liver	Vital organ which produces enzymes and bile needed to break down food
pancreas	Produces enzymes to break down food



herbivore	An animal that eats plants.
carnivore	An animal that feeds on other animals.
omnivore	An animal that eats plants and animals.
producer	A plant that produces its own food.
predator	An animal that hunts and eats other animals.
prey	An animal that gets hunted and eaten by another animal.
