<p>Mini beasts</p> 	<p>A small creature with no back bone, like an insect or spider</p>	<p>Farming</p> 	<p>The process of growing crops or animals</p>
<p>Flower</p> 	<p>A flower is the colourful part of a plant. They attract insects like bees and butterflies.</p>	<p>Tractor</p> 	<p>Powerful vehicle with large wheels that is used to perform jobs on a farm</p>
<p>Stem</p> 	<p>The long supportive middle part of a plant.</p>	<p>Ploughing</p> 	<p>Turning over the soil ready to then plant seeds</p>
<p>Root</p> 	<p>Roots grow under the ground. They hold the plant steady and take in water and food from the soil.</p>	<p>Planting</p> 	<p>Putting a seed, bulb or plant in the ground for it to grow</p>
<p>Leaf</p> 	<p>A flat part attached to the stem that uses light to make food</p>	<p>Harvesting</p> 	<p>Gathering a crop once it has grown</p>
<p>Islam</p> 	<p>The religion of Muslims</p>	<p>Life Cycle</p> 	<p>A living thing that gets bigger and changes over time.</p>
