

Read or share a book 3 times a week. To help your child's monkey climb up our 'Wild About Reading Tree', please make sure to record at least three separate reading sessions in their reading diary each week! 	Growing Up Talk! Ask your family what you were like as a baby and toddler. How have you changed? What's stayed the same? 	Feelings Collage! Use items from around your home (like LEGO, cereal or pebbles) to create a face showing a feeling — happy, sad or angry. Why might they feel that way? What could help them feel better? 	Village vs. City Walk! Go for a walk around Cropwell Bishop or explore pictures/videos of Nottingham. We'll be learning about the similarities and differences between village and city life. 
Practise dressing independently at home — especially turning clothes the right way round and putting on socks — to build speed and confidence for PE! 	Healthy Food Sorting! Can you sort foods at home into healthy and treat categories? Think about which ones we should enjoy often and which only occasionally. 	Counting Fun! Practise counting everyday objects up to 5. What happens if you add one more? Or take one away? Can you count forwards and backwards too? 	Model Classroom Challenge! Now that you've settled in, can you build your own classroom model? You could use LEGO, building blocks, cardboard boxes or small craft materials. Don't forget to take a photo and upload it to Tapestry! 
Map Drawing Challenge! Can you draw a map of Cropwell Bishop? Think about key places like the school, park and shop. Don't forget to snap a photo and upload it to Tapestry! 	Design Your Own Superhero! After learning about superheroes, can you create your own? What will their costume look like? What powers will they have? Who will they help? Don't forget to share your design on Tapestry! 	Let's Celebrate Achievements!
